Mikkel has taught and performed as a dancer and musician at workshops, festivals, and concerts throughout North America, Norway, and Sweden, and in Europe and St. Petersburg, Russia. Mikkel's knowledge of Scandinavian folk dance encompasses an astonishingly wide range of styles and traditions, and he is an accomplished musician on the munnøharpe (mouth harp) and torader (button accordion). Mikkel performed at the Norsk Høstfest in Minot, ND, for many years and was a part of the annual Calgary Folk Dance workshops from 2003 to 2018.

Ginny Lee (USA)

Ginny has taught and performed Scandinavian dance and music as part of folk dance groups, and, for workshops, festivals, and concerts throughout the USA and in Canada, Sweden, Europe, and St. Petersburg, Russia. Ginny performed for many years at the Norsk Høstfest in Minot, ND. She is an accomplished musician on the Nyckelharpa. Ginny instructed at the 2005 and 2016, 2017 and 2018 Calgary Folk Dance workshop.

Both Mikkel and Ginny have a warm, engaging style of teaching dance through which they encourage and inspire dancers of all ages and skill levels to have fun while learning Scandinavian folk dance.
